**Monday, February 3. Saint Blaise:** Bishop of Sebaste, he was martyred for refusing to renounce his Catholic faith. Priest usually bless throats in this day because St. Blaise, reportedly a physician, healed many ailments of the throat. *"Father of mercy and God of all consolation, graciously look upon me and impart to me the blessing which flows from this holy Sacrament."*



**Monday, February 3. Saint Ansgar:** missionary to Denmark and Sweden; bishop of Hamburg; great preacher and administrator; known as the "Apostle of the North; patron of Denmark, Germany and Iceland. *"If I were worthy of such a favor of my God, I would ask that he grant me this one miracle that by His grace, He would make me a good man."*



**Wednesday, February 5. Saint Agatha:** patroness of Palermo and Catania; invoked for protection against volcanic eruptions and fires; mentioned in the Roman Canon.

*"Jesus Christ, Lord of all things! You see my heart, you know my desires. Possess all that I am—you alone. I am your sheep; make me worthy to overcome the devil."*



**Thursday, February 6. Saint Paul Miki & Companions:** Paul Miki, Jesuit scholastic, and his twenty-five companions, including two other Jesuits, six Franciscans, fifteen tertiaries, and two laymen, were crucified by order of the ruler Hideyoshi 5 Feb. 1597 at Nagasaki; among them the Mexican, Felipe de Jesus, first martyr for the Americas to be beautified; protomartyrs of the Far East.
