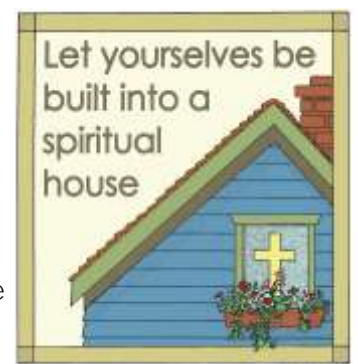

**THE WAY** Today we sense the apostles' trepidation as they begin to realize that the Lord would soon be leaving them. In their fear, they ask, "Master, we do not know where you are going; how can we know the way?" (John 14:5). Jesus tells them that *he* is the way. The Easter season has been a time of growing in Easter faith so that we, too, may learn to know that Jesus is the way. We can take comfort in the Lord's promise that he is going to his Father's house to prepare a place for us, his chosen people who have been called out of darkness into God's wonderful light. As the paschal candle continues to burn during this holy season, let us remember that in baptism we were given the light of Christ. With Christ our light as the beacon lighting our way, let us march toward the glory of Pentecost.







Wednesday, May 10. **Saint John of Avila:** was a Spanish priest, preacher, scholastic author, and religious mystic; called the "Apostle of Andalusia" for extensive ministry in that region of Spain; patron of Andalusia and Spanish secular clergy. *"Turn yourself round like a piece*

*of clay and say to the Lord: I am clay, and you, Lord, the potter. Make of me what you will."*

**Wednesday, May 10. Saint Damien de Veuster:** Belgian who joined Fathers of the Sacred Hearts of Jesus and Mary; began his work in Hawaii, on Moloka'i known as "Devil's Island," used as colony for over 800 lepers; man of intense interior life and deep simplicity. *"I make myself a leper with the lepers, to gain all for Jesus Christ."*



May 13. Our Lady of Fatima is venerated under this title following apparitions to three shepherd children in Portugal in 1917. The message of Fatima includes a call to conversion of heart, repentance from sin, and prayer, especially the Rosary.

**Fatima Prayer:**

*"O My Jesus, forgive us our sins, save us from the fires of hell. Lead all souls to Heaven, especially those in most need of Thy mercy."*



**Friday, May 12. Saints Nereus and Achilleus:** Pope St. Damasus states that they were Praetorian soldiers who converted to Christianity; their acta report that they were beheaded during the reign of

Trajan on the island of Terracina.

**Friday, May 12. Saint Pancras:** his 'acts' state that he was a Syrian or Phrygian orphan who came to Rome where he was converted to Christianity. He was beheaded under Diocletian in his fourteenth year; buried on the via Aurelia.
