



Saint John Fisher,  
Saint Thomas More  
**Saint Paulinus of Nola:** husband and father who gave his possessions to the poor; dedicated bishop, especially during Visigoth invasions. *"Let us listen to what all the faithful say, because in every one of them the Spirit of God*



**Saint Fisher:** beheaded 1535; chancellor, Cambridge University; bishop of Rochester; dedicated pastor of souls; renowned for his preaching, educational reforms. *"A good man is not a perfect man: good man is an honest man, faithful and unhesitatingly responsive to the voice of God in his life."*

**Saint Thomas More:** beheaded 1535; humanist and chancellor of England; close friend of Erasmus; wrote Utopia; refused to support Henry VIII's divorce of Queen Catherine and his Act of Supremacy; patron of lawyers, statesmen, and politicians.
