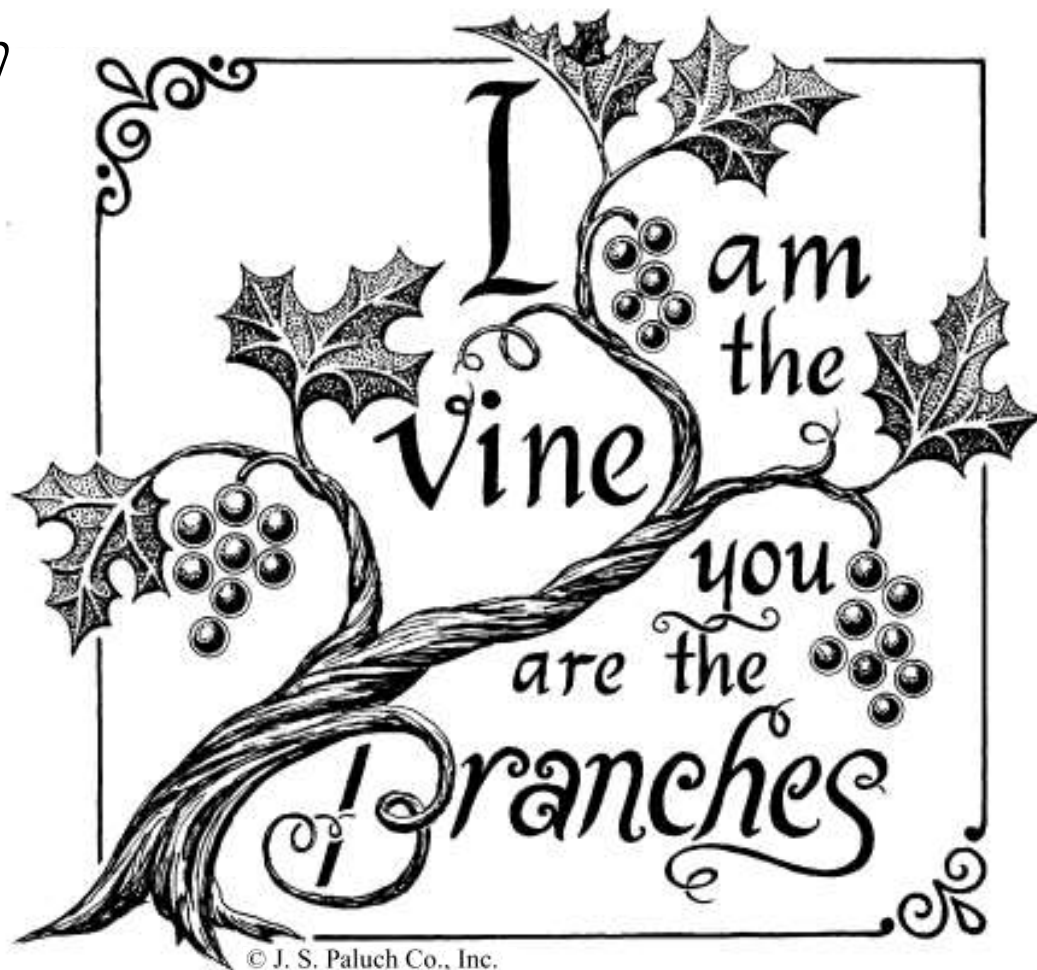

LIVING BRANCHES

The Gospel and second reading for this Fifth Sunday of Easter emphasize the need for us to remain in Christ, and he in us. This shared life finds expression in the image of the one vine and many branches. We become living branches of the vine, members of the Body of Christ through baptism,



Eucharist, and confirmation, sacraments of sharing God's own life.

The First Letter of John describes the fruit of this vine as active love of neighbor: “And his commandment is this: we should believe . . . and love one another” (1 John 3:23).

Our first reading from Acts shows us an example of someone who shares in Christ's life in the person of Saint Paul. Paul's fearless witness, even at the risk of his life, is proof to everyone that the risen Lord's Spirit truly fills him with life and is bearing fruit in him.

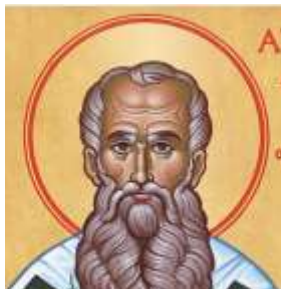

May 1-St. Joseph the Worker: entrusted with the care of the Blessed Mother and Jesus, he was a carpenter dedicated to his family, obedient to God. Proclaimed patron of the Universal Church 1870. Having died in the "arms of Jesus and Mary" considered model of pious believer who receives

grace at the moment of death, in other words, the patron of a happy death.

Thursday, May 2. Saint Athanasius: Bishop of Alexandria; champion of Nicea; prolific polemicist against the Arians who exiled him five times; one of four great doctors of Eastern Church; known as the "Doctor of the Incarnation."

Our Lady of Fatima Rosary Procession
Join faithful from throughout the area in a Rosary Procession on the Memorial of Our Lady of Fatima – Monday, May 13 at 7pm. The procession will begin at St. Alphonsus Church, 2111 Market Street, Wheeling, and end at the Cathedral of St. Joseph, 1300 Eoff Street, Wheeling. A brief prayer service will occur upon arrival at the Cathedral including Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament. For those who are unable or would prefer not to walk in the 0.6 mile procession, the rosary will be prayed at the Cathedral, awaiting the arrival of those in the procession. St. Philip was among the first disciples called by Jesus; tradition holds he preached in Phrygia, dying on a cross at Hierapolis; with James, venerated as the patron saints of Uruguay.
