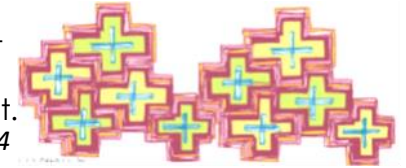

### GOD'S PROVIDENCE

Today's readings celebrate God's providence. No matter how wonderful (or heartbreaking) our relationships are, God always provides for us. No one cares for us the way God does. Isaiah delights us with a deeply intimate image of God caring for us "as a mother comforts her child." The prophet describes us not as the usual "children of God," but as "babies." We should not resist this image, but rejoice in it. Trusting in God's care, we can all let down our guard and rest like infants in the lap of our mother. Saint Paul's trust in God allows him to be at peace like this. He boldly declares that no one can "make troubles" for him, because he has given himself completely to Jesus. ## How many times can a person receive Holy Communion in one day?

The Code of Canon Law (No. 917) stipulates, “A person who has received the Most Holy Eucharist may receive it again on the same day only during the celebration of the Eucharist in which the person participates, with due regard for the prescription of Canon 921, 2.” Following this lead, Canon 921, 2 stipulates, “Even if they have received Communion in the same day, those who are in danger of death are strongly urged to receive again.” Succinctly, a person may receive Holy Communion twice a day.

A Catholic can receive the Sacrament of the Holy Eucharist at the most, 2 times per day, if certain conditions are met.

You may receive Holy Communion when:

You attend your two separate celebrations of the Holy Mass on the same day. [Canon Law # 917; C.C.C. # 1388]

You attend a regular daily Holy Mass and a funeral during which there is a Eucharistic celebration.

You attend a regular daily Holy Mass and a wedding during which there is a Eucharistic celebration.

You attend a regular daily Holy Mass and receive the Last Rites (Anointing of the Sick).

You attend a regular daily Holy Mass and a Vigil Holy Mass on the same day.

If a Catholic has already received the Sacrament of Holy Communion during the day and he is facing the danger of death, during the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick (Last Rites), he can once more receive the Sacrament of the Holy Eucharist on the same day. But, he cannot receive the Sacrament of the Holy Eucharist twice on the same day through the administration of the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick.

120 martyrs honored today died 1648-1930; most born in China, ages 9-72; four Chinese priests. Thirty-three foreign-born mostly priests or women religious. Augustine Zhao Rong was a Chinese soldier who accompanied prisoner Bishop John Dufresse to his martyrdom in Beijing; moved by bishop's courage, sought baptism and later ordained a diocesan priest.
