To celebrate the Year of the Holy Eucharist, Corpus Christi Parish has been hosting an evening Holy Hour every third Monday of the month. You are invited to attend this event in the month of December on the 18th at 6:00 pm to PRAY FOR PEACE: peace in our world, especially in the Ukraine and the Middle East, peace in our families, peace in our hearts.

Monday, December 11. **Saint Damasus:** preserved papal archives; devoted to the relics and resting places of the martyrs; first people to speak of Roma as the "Apostolic See" encouraged St. Jerome to produce a new translation of the Latin Bible, later to form the main part o the Vulgate.



Tuesday, December 12. **Our Lady of Guadalupe:** today's feast recalls the apparitions of Mary at the hill of Tepeyac from 9-12 Dec 1531 to the native convert, Juan Diego; declared patroness of the Americas by Pope Pius XII and raised to the rank of Feast for all the countries of the Americas by the Congregation for Divine Worship and the Discipline of the Sacraments. Wednesday, December 13. **Saint Lucy:** because of her name, she is the patroness of those afflicted with diseases of the eye and associated with festivals of light, especially in Scandinavia; mentioned in the Roman Canon; patroness of Syracuse and all Sicily. " Those whose hearts are pure are temples of the Holy Spirit."



Thursday, December 14. **Saint John the Cross:** born in Spain; mystic and poet; ally of Teresa of Jesus of Avila in founding reformed Carmelite friars; suffered imprisonment by the unreformed Carmelites; known as the "Mystical Doctor". "In the twilight of life, God will not judge us on our earthly possessions and human success, but rather on how much we have loved."
