# Devotions & Teachings

## WHAT IS FIRST FRIDAY?

“First Friday” is the first Friday of the month and is often marked by special devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus since Jesus died for us and won our salvation on a Friday.

At the end of the 17th century Our Lord appeared to St. Margaret Mary Alcoque (1647-1690) and asked her to spread devotion to His Most Sacred Heart. In a letter written to her Mother Superior in May 1688, St. Margaret Mary set out what is called The Great Promise Our Lord

made regarding the Nine First Fridays and what we must do to earn it:

1. Attend Holy Mass
2. Receive Communion
3. Go to Confession\*



## WHAT IS FIRST SATURDAY?

Devotion to the Immaculate Heart of Mary developed alongside devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. The heart of Mary mirrors the heart of Jesus both in great love and in sharing His suffering. This devotion increased after the appearances of the Blessed Mother to three children of Fátima, Portugal, early in the twentieth century. The Blessed Mother told the eldest of the children that she would “assist at the hour of death with all the graces necessary for the salvation of their souls” all who, for five months, on the first Saturday of each month:

1. Confess their sins,
2. Receive Holy Communion,
3. Recite the Rosary,
4. And keep Mary company for fifteen minutes while meditating on the fifteen mysteries of the Rosary,
5. All offered in a spirit of reparation.







**Saint Eusebius of Vercelli:** considered the founder of the canons regular in the West; defender of St. Athanasius; exiled to Palestine by Constantius; with St. Hilary, an opponent of Arianism.

*"It will sometimes be necessary to use falsehood for the benefit of those who need such a mode of treatment."*

**Saint Peter Julian Eymard:** French Catholic priest and founder of two religious institutes: the Congregation of the Blessed Sacrament for men and the Servants of the Blessed



Sacrament for women. Eymard entered the novitiate of the Oblates of Mary Immaculate in June 1829. His first attempt as a seminarian ended because of serious illness. Throughout his life, Eymard suffered from poor health, particularly 'weakness of the lungs' and migraine headaches.
