### A MINDSET OF SERVICE

There's a lot of traveling, delivering, and visiting going on in our readings today. In Genesis Abraham cares for the needs of three mysterious travelers. The psalm responds, celebrating the kind of righteousness that Abraham practices. Then, in his letter to the Colossians, Saint Paul describes his



own ministry as almost like a delivery service: he, God's steward, brings the word of God to their community. Finally, Luke's Gospel shares the well-known story of Mary and Martha, and the different ways they welcome Jesus into their home. Amid all this coming and going, we are invited to pay attention to the ways we tend to the needs of others. Each of us can ask, *How am I present to God and others in my life?* Copyright © J. S. # A Note from Fr. George

## Why can't non-Catholics receive Holy Communion in Catholic Church?

Catholics believe in the Real Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist, meaning that what appears to be bread and wine is really Jesus' body and blood—not just a symbol of his body and blood. When Catholics receive Holy Communion, it is an expression of the unity among all those in communion with the Catholic Church throughout the world, who maintain the belief in the Real Eucharistic Presence of Christ. Therefore, only those who believe in the True Presence may participate in this sacrament of oneness with Christ and his Church. "...

[T]he celebration of the Eucharistic sacrifice is wholly directed toward the intimate union of the faithful with Christ through communion" (CCC 1382).

Ultimately, Catholics believe that we cannot celebrate this unifying sacrament with other Christians while there are disagreements about the Eucharist itself. However, Catholics pray for the day when we can reconcile with other Christians and share in the unity of God's people through the Holy Eucharist.

The United States Conference of Catholic Bishops expresses this desire for unity:

"We pray that our common baptism and the action of the Holy Spirit in this Eucharist will draw us closer to one another and begin to dispel the sad divisions which separate us. We pray that these will lessen and finally disappear, in keeping with Christ's prayer for us 'that they may all be one'" (John 17:21).

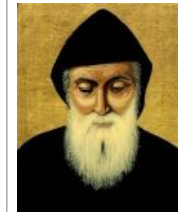
**Monday, July 21. Saint Lawrence of Brindisi:** Capuchin, linguist, military chaplain, diplomat and minister general; learned exegete, forceful preacher, and controversialist; fifteen volumes of his writings are extant.

*“God is love and all his operations proceed from love.”*

**Tuesday, July 22. Saint Mary Magdalene:** healer of possession; disciple of Jesus and present at his crucifixion; In Mark, first to witness to the risen Lord; patroness of the Order of Preachers.]

**Thursday, July 24. Saint Sharbel Makhluf:** born in 1828 in a small mountain village in north Lebanon, he became a monk of the Maronite Rite and was ordained a priest in 1859. Devoted to the Blessed Virgin Mary, he spent the last twenty-three years of his life as a hermit. Sharbel taught the value of poverty, self-sacrifice, and prayer by the life he lived. *“The things that go on within you are more important than those that take place in your life.”*

**Friday, July 25. Saint James:** “the Greater” because he followed Christ before the other apostle of the same name; first of the Twelve to be martyred, being decapitated by order of Herod Agrippa. *“Most treasured possessions are not things; they are only things, my friends, family and animals are what counts.”*



**Wednesday, July 23. Saint Bridget:** born in Sweden; mother of eight; mystic prophet and foundress of the Order of the Most Holy Savior; sought to end the luxury and dissipation of the Avignon papacy and the return of the pope to Rome; patroness of Sweden.
