

Votive Candles The light signifies our prayer offered in faith coming into the light of God. With the light of faith, we petition our Lord in prayer, or petition a saint to pray with us and for us to the Lord. The continually burning flame symbolizes ongoing nature of the prayer even after the person who lit the candle has left



church. Candles may be lit for loved ones who have died, in gratitude, supplication or any other intention. A small donation is requested to offset cost of candle. *Pray, give thanks*



EXPOSITION: people kneel as priest brings Holy Eucharist to the altar and place the Blessed Sacrament in monstrance. *O Salutaris Hostia* is sung. **ADORATION:** pray; read scripture, recite Rosary. **BENEDICTION:** priest goes to the altar, genuflects, kneels, incense Blessed Sacrament; *Tantum ergo* is sung. Priest leads people in prayer. After prayer, priest dons humeral veil, goes to altar, takes up the monstrance, turn towards the congregation. Elevating monstrance, priest solemnly blesses people by slowly making the sign of the cross with the Blessed Sacrament; returns, kneels and lead Divine Phrases. **REPOSITION:** hymn *Holy God, we praise thy name* is sung. The priest goes to the altar, genuflects, removes the Blessed Sacrament from the monstrance, places it in the pyx. He goes to the tabernacle to repose the Blessed Sacrament within it; withdraw to sacristy.
