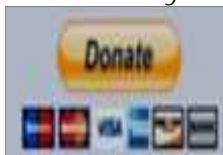

WISDOM

We consider wisdom today. The first reading from the book of Wisdom presents this precious gift as a feminine spirit, a very desirable virtue sought by many and graciously present to all who seek her. In today's Gospel, Jesus tells a parable to illustrate wisdom in a practical, measurable way. The wise will conserve their resources, use them prudently, and mark the passing of time. The foolish, on the other hand, not planning ahead, will be in the dark. Both of these readings tell us how accessible wisdom is to all who simply and honestly seek it.

Paul's words to the Thessalonians are not about wisdom, but describe one result of true wisdom: To the wise person of faith even death holds no terror. Our faith in Jesus' resurrection tells us we will all one day rise to new life in Christ.

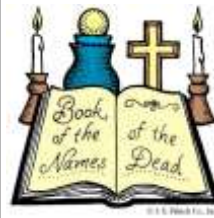

Wednesday, November 15. **St. Albert the Great:** master of philosophy, theology, and natural sciences, especially Aristotle; prolific writer; wrote on cult of the Sacred Heart; patron of scientist. *"The greater and more persistent your confidence in God, the more abundantly you will receive all that you ask."*



Saint Margaret of Scotland: wife of King Malcolm III of Scotland and mother of eight children; helped root out paganism; her love for the poor became legendary; patroness of Scotland. *"As I hope in thee, O Lord, inspire me with that confidence which rings me to thy holy mountain."*



Thursday, November 16

Friday, November 17. **St. Elizabeth of Hungary:** wife of Louis IV of Thuringia and mother of three; as a widow, she became Franciscan tertiary, dedicated to the needs of the poor and the sick; canonized only four years after her death; patroness of Franciscan Third Order and of Catholic charities. *"How could I bear a crown of gold when the Lord bears crown of thorns? And bears it for me!"*



Saint Gertrude: Benedictine mystic of the famous Benedictine abbey of Helfta in Saxony; wrote on meaning of suffering, the Sacred Heart, the Trinity, God's love; most important work: the *Herald of Diving Love*. *"Every time we look at the Blessed Sacrament our place in heaven is raised forever."*
