

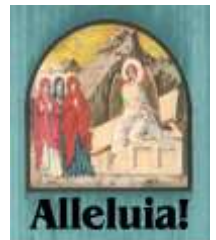

Lenten renewal for the family. Lent is not just about sacrifice. This is also a time to make changes that will either bring us closer to God or give him a central place in our family life. Consider these ideas: BAN SPORTS TEAMS OR ACTIVITIES THAT INTERFERE WITH ATTEND MASS. If you have to choose between travel soccer or baseball and attending Mass on Sunday, find a different soccer or baseball team. For Catholics, Eucharist and Mass come before everything. MAKE SUNDAY ABOUT YOU AND GOD. Fix dinner on Saturday; warm it up on Sunday. Use disposable plates so there are not dishes to wash. Postpone errands or chores to another day.
