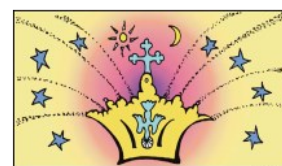

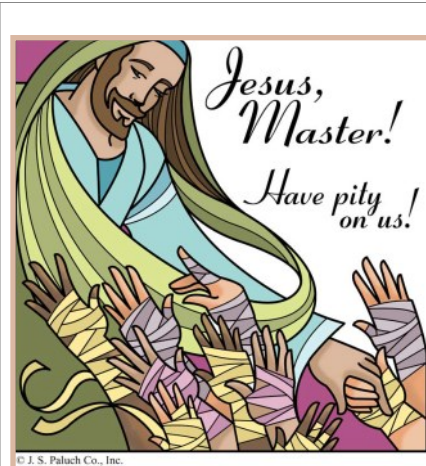
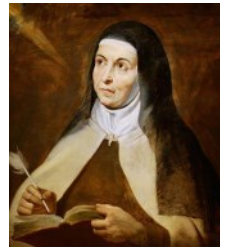

**October 14. Saint Callistus I:** incurred the ire of Tertullian and St. Hippolytus over *lapsi* controversy; organized the first official Christian cemetery in Rome and instituted Ember Day fasts. *"In the Lord's hand there is abundance of all things, because He is the Lord of powers and the King of glory."*

**October 15. Saint Teresa of Jesus:** Spanish mystic who with St. John of the Cross, founded the reformed Carmelite friars and nuns for which she had to endure great trials; first woman declared "Doctor of the Church"; patroness of Spain. *"Let nothing disturb you. Let nothing frighten you. Everything passes away except God. God alone is sufficient."*



### HEALING AND SALVATION

The readings today speak of healing and salvation. In Second Kings, Naaman, a commander of the army of the king of Syria, develops leprosy. He goes to a stranger, a prophet from Israel, when no one else can cure his disease. Much to his surprise, after a simple bath in the river, he is cured. In Luke's Gospel, Jesus cures ten lepers and sends them to the priest. Only one, a Samaritan, returns to thank Jesus for his cure and only he hears the words, "Your faith has saved you." The psalm and Timothy remind us that salvation involves justice, kindness, faithfulness and forever links us with Jesus. In a world as broken as ours, both healing, salvation are necessary.

# A Note from Fr. George

## Funeral and Burial Rites

In our ever-changing society, our funeral rites and burial practices have evolved. With the Church’s acceptance of cremation (in most cases) and funeral homes now offering “one-stop” services, young family members who no longer practice the faith will frequently choose burial rites with little or no religious observance. The wishes of the parents and grandparents are not always respected. A baptized person has a right to the full funeral and burial rites of the Church which include a Mass of Christian Burial where the body or the ashes of the deceased are present within the parish Church. Note that if cremation is to take place, the Church strongly recommends that it be done after the funeral. The presence of the body at the visitation (in an open or closed casket). and at the funeral, adds a dignity and meaning to the ceremony which can be lost if only the urn is present. To assure that you receive the funeral rites and services of the Church upon death, you are advised to leave written funeral and burial instructions with your next of kin and with the funeral home, and also with the parish if you wish. I am always available to meet you and your family to advise you.

I will be traveling home on Tuesday, October 14th, and will return on November 14th. While I am away, if you have any pastoral needs, please contact the parish office. Priests will be available to take care of all pastoral needs during my absence.

**October 16. Saint Hedwig:** duchess of Silesia mother of seven children; peacemaker dedicated to poor and prisoners; as a widow, retired to Cistercian convent. *“ Would you oppose the will of God? Our lives are His.”*



**October 17. Saint Ignatius of Antioch:** Apostolic Father known as the second successor of St. Peter in Antioch; wrote seven letters to local communities on church unity and structure, esp., the monoepiscopacy;



first to use the term “Catholic Church” as a collective designation for Christians. *“We are not asked merely to call ourselves Christians; we are asked to be Christians through our deeds”*

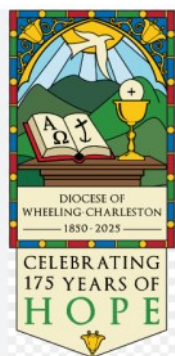
