Gaining Plenary Indulgence for the Souls in Purgatory from November 1 to 8

An indulgence, applicable only to the Souls in Purgatory, is granted to the faithful, who devoutly visit a cemetery and pray, even if only mentally, for the departed. Indulgence is plenary November 1-8; on other days of the year it is partial. To acquire a plenary indulgence, it is necessary to perform the work to which the indulgence is attached and to fulfill the following three conditions: sacramental confession, Eucharistic Communion, and prayer for the intention of the Sovereign Pontiff. It is further required that all attachment to sin, even venial sin, be absent. The three conditions may be fulfilled several days before or after the performance of the prescribed work; it is, however, fitting that

Communion be received and the prayer for the intention of the Sovereign Pontiff be said on the same day the work is performed. A single sacramental confession suffices for gaining several plenary indulgences; but Communion must be received and prayer for the intention of the Sovereign Pontiff must be recited for the gaining of each plenary indulgence. The condition of praying for the intention of the Sovereign Pontiff is fully satisfied by reciting one Our Father and one Hail Mary; nevertheless, each one is free to recite any other prayer according to his piety and devotion. (Book The Enchiridion of Indulgences)
