#### PARTNERS IN THE PROMISE

As a society, during these days we can be in something of a "postpartum" depression. Our celebrations of Christmas and the New Year are over, and after today many of us will put away the decorations and the last visible remnants of the celebrations of the past weeks. The apostle Paul today uses the expression "partners in the promise." This is an uplifting phrase for us to reflect upon, and to think of as our own calling in these days following the birth of the Lord. What is this promise? We can find it in the gifts the magi bring: it is a promise of being a royal priesthood (gold), a holy nation (frankincense), a people set apart for self-giving (myrrh). We find more of the promise in Isaiah—a light shines upon us! In the psalm we know a promise of a world of flowering justice, profound peace, the poor rescued, pity for the lowly and the poor. This is the promise; and one of the best ways for us to lift ourselves out of any possible low spirits we may be suffering is to live out our partnership in this promise each and every day.

### **New Year's Family Faith Resolutions**

The New Year offers us a new beginning with opportunities to change and grown when we make and keep resolutions. A good way to teach children the importance of New Year's

resolutions is to turn them into a family activity. Try these ideas for a faith-based New Year's

a faith-based New Year's resolutions: Make family activity. Take turns telling what you each like about your relationship with God and what you would like to change. It may help if parents demonstrate. Then, using their comments, write down a brief list of goals for every person. Make it age appropriate. Resolutions get kept.

What each child needs to resolve depends on the child. Gently steer youngsters toward age appropriate prayer times, works of charity (chores, contributions to the poor box or parish collections) or Scripture reading. Limit the number of resolutions so they are doable

throughout the year. Post each person's resolutions in a prominent place in the home. Be a role

model. Children of any age will understand the value of working to grow in faith if parents lead.

As a family, periodically review resolution progress but make it a time of encouragement, not punishment. Praise effort. The best part is you are working together to

grow in faith and love of God. That has its own reward.
