



MARCH 28. HOLY THURSDAY at 7:00pm

Evening Mass of the Lord's Supper is the Thursday before Easter. Commemorates the Last Supper. Observed with foot washing, and our prayer vigil to keep watch with Jesus in the garden (Altar of Repose in Peace Family Center until midnight).

MARCH 29. GOOD FRIDAY

Friday of the Passion of the Lord. Friday before Easter. Most solemn day of the church year. Observes the day Jesus was crucified. Fasting and abstinence. Praying of the Stations of the Cross at 6:00 pm, the reading of the Lord's Passion and Veneration of the Cross at 7:00 pm.

MARCH 30. EASTER VIGIL at 8:30pm

Easter Vigil begins outside after sunset, with the blessing of Easter Fire and from it the Pascal Candle, which is then brought into the darkened church.





MARCH 31. EASTER SUNDAY MASSES at 6:00, 8:30, 10:30am



The Resurrection of the Lord. This day we celebrate the resurrection of Jesus. We hear the Gospel according to John: "On the first day of the week, Mary of Magdala came to the tomb early in the morning, while it was still dark, and saw the stone removed from the tomb...." The Renewal of Baptismal Promises takes place. (Easter Egg Hunt begins immediately after 10:30am mass, lower lot)
