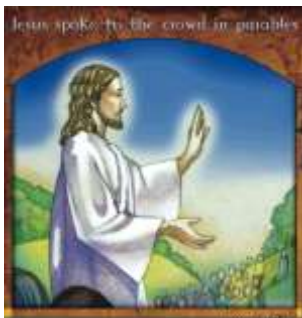

THE MERCY, POWER, AND LOVE OF GOD The first reading today, from the book of Wisdom, makes its point over and over, at least five times in five verses! God is mighty, but lenient to all. God's power is shown in kindness, clemency; not in harshness and condemnation, and those who govern God's people must govern in the same way, with kindness. This loving kindness and gentleness is not contrary to God's might, but is a direct result of God's primacy over all. Who are we, then, to judge what is in the hearts of our fellow Christians and all people, when God commands justice with love and clemency? Likewise, the Holy Spirit makes up for our ignorance of what we need, speaking in a language we do not yet understand. But God knows our needs before we do, understands the intercessions of the Spirit, and helps us in our weakness. This is our hope: God's mercy, power, and love.

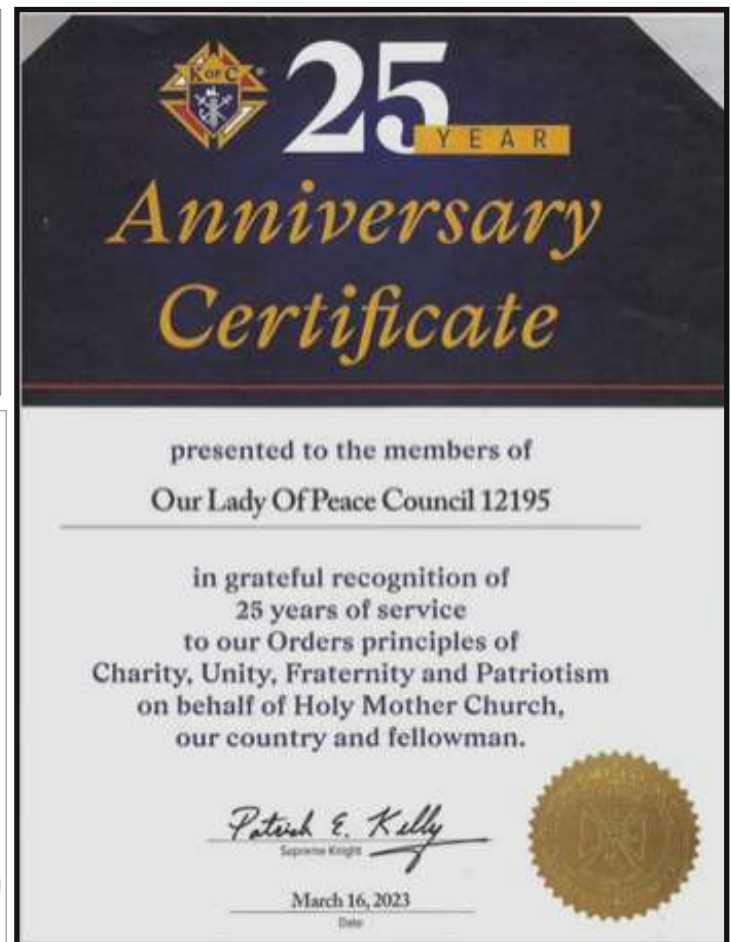

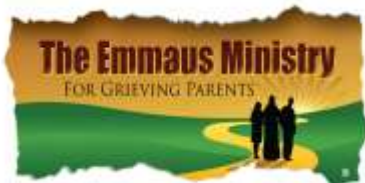

Monday, July 24. Saint Sharbel Makhluf: born in village north Lebanon; became monk of Maronite Rite, was ordained priest 1859; devoted to the Blessed Virgin Mary, spend last twenty-three years of life as hermit. Despite temptations to wealth and comfort, taught the value of poverty, self-sacrifice and prayer by life he lived; possessed gift of performing miracles even during his lifetime; known as “Hermit of Lebanon”
“Begin nothing on earth unless it has its end in heaven; do not walk on a path that does not lead to heaven.”



Tuesday, July 25. Saint James: James, brother of John, is called “the Greater” because he followed Christ before the other apostle of the same name; first of the Twelve to be martyred, being decapitated by order of Herod Agrippa; venerated at Compostella, Spain, named in the Roman Canon, patron of pilgrims, of Spain, Guatemala and Nicaragua.
